REVIEW OF PCV STANDING COMPETITION RULES

From time to time it is necessary to conduct a wholesale review of processes and procedures that guide the governance and conduct of any organisation. PCV competition is no exception.

Sometimes changes to cars specifications of what is or is not allowed may be made and an update is required. The Competition Committee has also noted that a change to the processes surrounding a dynamometer test is required.

The review is intended to increase the applicability of the rules to the 2010 racing season.

A review of the PCV Standing Competition Rules was announced at President's Day yesterday. The date and the venue is 7:00pm - 9:00pm on Wednesday 11th November 2009 in the boardroom of Porsche Cars Australia, 109 Victoria Street Collingwood.

You are welcome to attend and have your suggestions heard or to provide a written submission (email or letter) prior to this day. As the dynamometer test process is likely to be the one that interests many this will be discussed first.
