PCV is participating in a regularity run as part of the Shannons National series at Sandown on 28-29 Nov.

This is an excellent opportunity for more track time at Sandown and to play with the big boys of the GT3 Challenge plus many other motor sport categories in a national race meeting.

We did this at Phillip Island earlier in the year with the 356 and 901 Clubs and had a great time. It was wet and we had no incidents. Mixing with all of the other competitors at such a big race meeting was also great fun.

The format is:-

Sat 28 Nov approx 12.00-3.00 - register, scrutineering, and then 15 min practice 2.30-2.45pm to get an idea of the lap time to

nominate for Sunday.

Sun 29 Nov 8-9.45 - drivers to start line for 9.00 start, then 40 min regularity. Presentation approx 10am.

We will need the names and licences of all entrants by 6 Nov. The entry fee is \$165.

Entrants must have a Cams L2S licence and a helmet. The cars need a minimum of a 3 point harness, a firmly mounted fire extinguisher, 2 separate fasteners on any front opening panel, and numbers on each side. Please refer to the regulations for other information.
