After debuting the 911 in the 1965 Monte Carlo Rally, Porsche went on to notch up many victories with the 911 in the European Rally Championship. Porsche also competed with factory backed cars in many other gruelling rallies such as the famous Tour de Corse and the Tour de France.



Without doubt, Porsche's early rallying contributed greatly to developing the fame and character of the 911. Despite this, Porsche's early rallying history is often overlooked by its enormous success on the race track. This special evening will look back on the 911's early rally history and offer early 911 enthusiasts a few special treats.

In keeping with the rally theme, the evening will be held at the most impressive facilities of Subaru Interactive @ Docklands. Like Porsche and its success in early rallying, Subaru has enjoyed phenomenal success in modern rallying, including several consecutive World and Australian Rally Championships.

The evening will involve the display of several early 911s (hoping to get some with rally history). One of Subaru's factory backed rally cars will also be on display.

Several of the cars will give demonstrations on Subaru's state of the art interactive dyno (supervised by an experienced dyno technician). It will be interesting to see how the early 911s compare between themselves. It will also be interesting to see a "*then and now*" comparison between the early 911 rally cars and the very powerful modern Subaru version.

We'll also be serving a few drinks and nibbles, so it should be a great night.
