

Porsche Club of Victoria Tasmanian Fire Appeal Tour April 2014

Day 1: Monday 07 April 2014 - Melbourne to Devonport

Overnight Sail with Spirit of Tasmania including Twin Inside Cabins and a standard size vehicle each way

Day 2: Tuesday 08 April 2014 – Devonport to Strahan

Arrive into Devonport bright and early, and enjoy a delicious breakfast at Anvers Chocolate Factory in Latrobe.

Spend the morning visiting Sheffield 'The Town of Murals', view the many painted buildings and visit the Kentish Museum (donation required for entry).

Detouring into Cradle Mountain, stop at Cradle Mountain Chateau for a delicious lunch. Stop at the visitor Centre and take the shuttle bus to the spectacular Dove Lake Lookout for a photo stop before getting back on the road.

Travelling south through the western wilderness, drive through the historic towns of Tullah and Rosebery, which once housed hundreds of miners. Stop in Zeehan, once a wealthy silver town, optionally visit the West Coast Pioneers Museum (entry fees apply). Arrive into Strahan late afternoon. Dinner will be included within your hotel.

DAY 3: Wednesday 09 April 2014 – Strahan

Today you will immerse yourself into the wilderness on the Gordon River Cruise. As you journey deep into beautiful World Heritage Area, view the ancient rainforests reflected on the Gordon River. Tour includes lunch. An option for the West Coast Wilderness Railway may be available if operating. Tonight will include a delicious dinner at Risby Cove.

DAY 4: Thursday 10 April 2014 – Strahan - Hobart

After breakfast drive through the bare hills of Queenstown, once home to one of the world's richest mines.

Stopping at Derwent Bridge, lunch will be included at the Derwent Bridge Hotel. Optionally visit "The Wall in the Wilderness", a unique sculpture carved from 3 meter high wooden panels (entry fees apply). The unique carved panels tell the history of the harsh Central Highlands.

Drive south through Bushy Park, home of the hop farms, through the peaceful town of New Norfolk and arrive into Hobart late afternoon.

A relaxing dinner will be included within your hotel.

DAY 5: Friday 11 April 2014 – Hobart – Port Arthur

As you journey down the Tasman Peninsular, stop at Dunalley to visit the Primary School. The children will have the opportunity to view the cars and have a photo.

Continue to Port Arthur Historic Site for lunch, followed by a 45 minute walking tour, harbour cruise and access to the many buildings and gardens.

Drive back to Hobart mid afternoon.

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DAY 6: Saturday 12 April 2014 – Hobart

This morning explore the famous Salamanca Market, where you can taste, view and purchase some of Tasmania's gourmet produce, arts and crafts.
Walk back to the hotel by midday to drive down to the award winning Frogmore Creek Winery (previously Meadowbank Winery) in Cambridge for lunch.

Spend the afternoon visiting the historic town of Richmond, home to the oldest bridge still in use in Australia, as well as the oldest gaol still intact.

Tonight will include the final presentation dinner within your hotel.

Day 7: Sunday 13 April 2014 - Hobart – Devonport

Depart Hobart, touring up the Midlands Highway stop into the historic town of Oatlands for morning tea at Casaveen Cafe, also home to the luxury Casaveen Knitwear which is manufactured on the property.
Further north, detour through the pretty town of Ross before continuing to Symmons Plains Raceway. Those venturing to Bruny Island will head south from Hobart rather than visiting Symmons Plains.
Arrive into Devonport in the afternoon in time to check in for your return sailing with Spirit of Tasmania.

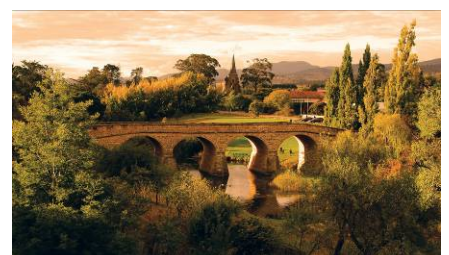
